Happy Advent! We are winding down the first half of our fraternal year and commemorating the first coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, while anticipating His second coming. Many of our acquaintances, family, friends, and strangers may ask us about the date of Christmas. We do not know the precise date of Jesus' birth because a specific date is not given in the Bible. What is known is that the Annunciation was and is still celebrated today on March 25th. Nine months after March 25th is December 25th.

The Mass of Christ is where we remember that Christ died for us and then came back to live. In our original history, the Christ-Mass Service was the only on celebrated after sunset and before dawn the next day. The Christ-Mass, shortened to Christmas was first recorded on December 25, 336, during the reign of the first Roman Christian Emperor, Constantine. Soon after this time, Pope Julius I officially declared the Celebration of the Birth of Jesus to be observed on December 25th.



Once you receive it, you will need to have the trousers & blazer altered (the trousers come unhemmed), and will need to shape your beret. Additionally, you will need to purchase a sword and service baldric, which can be done through www.kofcsupplies.com. The cost of a basic package (sword, baldric, and sword case) is \$199, plus shipping.


