### HLM in Council, but not 4<sup>th</sup> Degree (Assembly)

A frequently asked question: I am an Honorary Life Member in my Council, but not 4<sup>th</sup> Degree... WHY IS THIS? Answer: Honorary Life Membership in the Council is based on when a member takes his 1<sup>st</sup> (Admissions) Degree; Honorary Life Membership in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree is based on the date of the same member's 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Exemplification date.

### Assembly Activities: Expenses & Receipts

In order to confirm proper accounting and reporting of Assembly receipts and expenses, as with Council practices, all income from activities, social events, dinners, etc., is to be forwarded to the Faithful Comptroller, or in his absence the Faithful Purser. The Comptroller will confirm the amounts received and disburse to the Purser for deposit. Likewise, the same applies to amounts to be expensed. All requests for reimbursement are to be forwarded to the Comptroller for processing of payment.

In the event of joint Assembly functions (i.e., Installation of Officers, Renewal of Obligations, etc.) where funds need to be requested from the other Assemblies or we need to expense funds to them, the Faithful Comptroller will be responsible for communicating this information. Again, this is consistent with Assembly and Council practices.

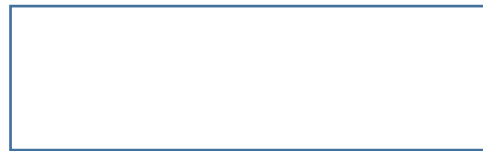
