Assembly vs. Council

Fourth degree Assemblies function similarly to that of Councils, however, they are SEPARATE entities and have separate charters. Also, each Council and Assembly separately assess dues. Councils are comprised of 1st, 2nd and 3rd Degree members and are led by a Grand Knight. Assemblies are comprised of 4th Degree members from assigned feeder Councils and are led by a Faithful Navigator. To be a member of an Assembly requires members to also be in good standing with their Councils. When attending Council meetings, members are required to present their Council membership card. However, attending Assembly meetings or 4th Degree exemplifications requires the presentation of BOTH the Council AND Assembly membership cards.

Assembly Dues

Assembly dues are assessed at \$30 annually and are based on a calendar year. My thanks to those members who have paid their Assembly dues for the 2020 calendar year.
