My Brother Sir Knights,

Come, Lord Jesus! Please, Lord, make haste, and put an end to the mess that we are in! But the question is: do we live like we believe it? A quick overview of the writings of New Testament letters reveals that St. Paul wanted the whole world to hear the Good News before the Lord came back. When the first Christians started to die of old age some began to grumble saying, "What is taking Him so long?! Maybe He is not coming at all..." St. Peter responded to this protest by saying that it is to our own benefit that the Lord has given us one more day: for we have one more day to make Jesus known, one more day to repent, one more day to pray... and we are not guaranteed that we will have tomorrow to do this.

The end of our national political season providentially coincides with the beginning of our Church's liturgical season of Advent.

"Come, Lord Jesus! Come and give me your spirit of courage to be your witness at work and at home. Come and convict our elected officials to protect the weak and the vulnerable; especially the preborn and the elderly. Come and inspire me to make the bold proclamation of your risen glory. Come and convict those who are steeped in sin and promote evil to repent. Come and help me to make you known before it is too late. Come into my life and purify everything that does not belong to you. Come to help me repent so when I see you face to face there will be nothing between us."

The liturgical season of Advent is penitential. This penance is designed to make room in our hearts for the first coming of Jesus as a baby, the second coming of Jesus as Judge, and His "third coming" today—right now—in prayer and in sacrament.

May we enter into this holy season of Advent with renewed zeal and conviction that we are one day closer to His Second coming. Maranatha! Come Lord Jesus!

REGALIA GUIDELINES

From time to time, we are called upon to wear Regalia. Here is a brief description of the regulations that we must follow:

SOCIAL Regalia: This is the basic regalia. Black dress shoes (preferably shiny "patent-leather") 4th Degree lapel pin (PG-113) must be worn on the left lapel of the jacket... NO other pins are permitted!!! Black socks Black tuxedo trousers with the satin stripe along the outside A Sir Knight who is entitled to a "Past" and/or "Former" title (Past Faithful Navigator, Past Grand Knight, Former District Black cummerbund (NO vests!) Deputy, etc.) should wear the corresponding miniature White tuxedo shirt with small pleats (NO ruffles, large ribbons; multiple ribbons should be on a multiple ribbon bar pleats, or flat fronts) when possible Black bow-tie Current Officers should wear their jewel of office: if they Black tuxedo jacket with notched collar hold offices on both the 3rd & the 4th Degree levels, they Black studs & cufflinks (they may have a gold or silver ring should wear the jewel that corresponds with the event (that on the outside, but must be predominantly black in color) is, a Council event would warrant the 3rd Degree jewel, but Social Baldric, which is to be worn under the jacket from the an Assembly event would warrant the 4th Degree jewel) right shoulder to the left hip Name badge should be worn when in Social Regalia **SERVICE Regalia:** This is when we truly become VISIBLE! Everything as outlined in Social Regalia is the same, with the following exceptions: Service Baldric, which hangs over the right shoulder to the Gold Plated Sword for Current and Former Masters (District, left hip, is to be worn over the jacket. Vice Supreme, and Supreme) Sword is to be attached to the Service Baldric, unless Capes & Chapeau: Red Cape & White Chapeau: all Sir Knights otherwise directed. Cape is to be worn with the chain under the bow-tie; it should Purple Cape & Chapeau: Current Color Corps Commander be wrinkle-free White Cape & Chapeau: Current and Past Faithful Chapeau is to be worn with the base parallel to the ground Navigators when Sir Knight stands at attention Green Cape & Chapeau: Current District Marshal Name badge should NOT be worn when in Service Regalia Gold Cape & Chapeau: Current and Former District Masters Swords: Light Blue Cape & Chapeau: Current and Former Vice Black Handled Sword for all Sir Knights Supreme Masters White Handled Sword for Current and Past Faithful Dark Blue Cape & Chapeau: Current and Former Supreme Navigators Masters **Faithful Officers** Faithful Navigator: SK David J.
