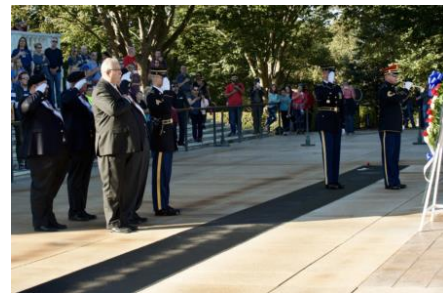
Commander's Report
